

The contest *BLUE DEAL for the Future* is now in its closing phase, and the regional evaluation committees have designated the teams that will participate in the international selection later this week, and compete to gain access to the finals, which will be held in Ravenna (Italy) on May 18th, during the Blue Deal Final Conference.

A panel of experts from ENEA, which has been coordinating the initiative for the Lazio-Campania area and in charge for the dissemination activities aimed at secondary education students, evaluated the proposals submitted by the participating schools, for the three categories of *design*, video and *artistic expression*. The high quality of the works presented by the students testifies the success of the initiative, and at the same time made it difficult for the commission to select the winning teams. The commission indeed appreciated the originality and the potential for exploitation of all the proposals, and regretted having to rank them and indicate a single winner.

- **Design:**

- **Video:**
 - *Looking for proposals* (short documentary) – Team: Calamandrei 3 - School: Liceo P. Calamandrei (Napoli).
